The Jump Start program is off to a great start with more than 80 students attending. The primary focus of this program is to increase student reading proficiency with a specific focus on reading comprehension. Professional development focused on utilizing explicit reading strategies in combination with the High Yield Strategies. In addition, we have stressed the use of non-fiction text which is critical for developing strategic readers.
