A bid document was posted on the Livonia Public School School District website and emailed to vendors on file for the purchase of 324 secondary instructional computers. A public bid opening was held at 2:00 p.m. on April 12, 2011, with one vendor in attendance and nine (9) vendors responding to our request for bids.
