Attached is the Enrollment Balancing Survey and Comments as of 12-7-10. Please note that the options are ranked from 1 - 5 with one being the best option, so the lower numbers represent the most popular options. In my assessment, it looks like moving new students from Brockett to Monaco is slightly the most popular option with moving the fifth grade to the middle school and redrawing district lines within a tenth of a percent. Realistically, those three options are evenly split with our community. The least popular option is moving kinder to Monaco. The comments are also very informative. A few people mentioned the option of having an elementary and an intermediate school, and many parents preferred that small children stay in a school close to home. Some comments addressed the issue of moving small children from building to building.
