


The school board and committees are working in the best interest of the students and CCS. 17 responses




I would describe CCS as a safe and orderly place.








My student is well prepared for their next level of schooling through the curriculum, testing, and supplemental resources offered at CCS.



It's appalling that no safety drills were done until the last month of school. No active shooter drills. Nothing. Till end of school. How does that help keep our kids safe?


