Advanced Placement, Dual Credit, and other college level courses are taught at the college level, which is more rigorous than a high school course. Our goal is to better prepare students for upper level college courses while understanding the rigor and time management expectations will be more challenging. In light of the changes below, students will need to keep apprised of their average as the semester progresses.

- Grades will be weighted with the following percentages and the minimum number of grades for each six weeks. (which is different from other high school courses)
  - 60% Major Grades - minimum of 1 per six weeks
  - 40% Daily Grades - minimum of 3 per six weeks
- Students will not have the opportunity to make corrections or retest in advanced courses.
- Semester average
  - Each six weeks will be weighted 25% and the final exam is weighted 25% of the semester grade.
- Semester exam
  - Dual credit students must take their final exam as part of their college course grade.
