## Musical Instruments—Rental District Owned

The Board of Education shall provide musical instruments to beginning Instrumental Exploratory class students of in grades five and seven to enable them to explore their interests and talents in this area of instruction without making the investment in an instrument. More specifically, the following regulations shall govern the providing of musical instruments by the Board of Education:

- 1. Song flutes Recorders and music books will be provided for all students in the fifth fourth grade.
- 2. Instruments will be provided for all beginning Instrumental Exploratory students in the fifth and seventh grades and for students of any grade whose parents are unable to provide them for financial reasons.
- 3. Large or unusual instruments, such as bass, baritone, oboe, bassoon, etc., will be provided by the board of Education.
- 4. Except as indicated in items 1, 2, and 3, above, students will be expected to provide their own instruments.
- 5. Ensemble/methods books and performance music will be provided.

A \$10 fee per school year is charged those students using school-owned instruments to cover the annual repair and renovation of the instrument.

The student and parent may be responsible for the cost to repair or replace an instrument that has been lost or damaged.
