Campus Updates

AEP

17 students currently enrolled. One of our 8th grade students will go on homebound instruction soon (due March 5th) to have a baby. We are wishing her the very best! All educational arrangements have been made. This is an exemplary student who has taken advantage of all her opportunities at Wallace. She will return to us as a 9th grader. Homebound instruction will consist of 8th grade STAAR preparation.

DAEP

DAEP has one 5th grade student, one 6th grade student, one 7th grade student, and one eighth grade student from CMS. There is one 11th grade student assigned from CHS, and one 12th grade student from Wallace. DAEP students have very few social distractions and tend to require and complete a much greater amount of school work than they typically would in a traditional setting.

Community Update

Wallace students have started a new YPA (Youth for Public Art) project and plan to complete the project and present it by the end of the school year.

Restorative Discipline

It is my intent to start restorative dialogue with the high school students assigned to DAEP this month.
