

TRANSPORTATION BOARD REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2017

We had to bring our Coach bus to Missoula to get the air conditioner leaks repaired. The bus seems to be running a lot better now. The air conditioning is staying on.

Our drivers started cleaning buses for the bus inspection that will take place at the end of July 2017. They are busy cleaning the engines, inside of the buses top to bottom, armoralling the front dashes, washing the windows inside and out, and repairing the seats.

We have a bus driver go over to food services daily to drive the food bus and help them where needed while on site.

The mechanics are busy working on all the buses making sure everything is still working properly on them. They are servicing district vehicles at the same time.

We went to Greatfalls to the Montana Association of Pupil Transportation Training and they updated us on the minimum requirement of training hours to be 15 instead of 10. We had to take extra classes they provided to get the 15 hours. New driver's licenses will start to be issued in 2018 up until 2020. These licenses will have a mark on them with updated information so they will be considered a real license. The license we possess now in Montana are not recognized as a real I. D. the real I.D. can be used like a passport.

We let the County Superintendent know about the refusal of Routes 1 and 2 for Heart Butte coming into our district and for Cutbank's route 1. He said the School Superintendent needs to write a letter and get it to Heartbutte and Cutbank's schools with a copy of their requests.

We plan on having our bus inspections at the end of July sometime we have to get with the Highway Patrol to see what day they are available to come do them.

We hauled 2300 hundred people to Kiowa and dropped them off so they could run a half marathon to East Glacier Park Lodge then we hauled them back to the Native American Indian Days campground where they were staying for the race.

We had a total of 20 Activity trips for the month of June. This concludes our report.
