Memorandum of Understanding Education Service Center, Region 20 and South San Antonio Independent School District

Purpose & Timeframe: This memorandum addresses the required areas of service in accordance with Education Service Center, Region 20 and South San Antonio Independent School District for the English as a Second Language (ESL) Framework Pilot Project. This project will provide a series of professional development opportunities to assist LEA staff in the implementation of the ESC-20 ESL framework.

This pilot project will be in effect from August 2019 – August 2020. Subsequent plans may be negotiated on a yearly basis thereafter should the services agreed upon require amendments.

Education Service Center, Region 20 will:

- Assist in identification, development, and delivery of effective professional development and onsite coaching to support teachers in the implementation of the ESL Framework.
- Work with district and campus personnel to develop long-term systematic staff development plans for teachers based on identified needs of English learners that are prioritized in the district and campus goals.
- · Conduct monitoring activities to review the implementation of the project goals.

The LEA will:

- Provide opportunities for eligible teachers to attend identified professional development sessions.
- Support the implementation of the ESL Pilot Project by participating in scheduled meetings and training provided by ESC-20 staff.
- Share relevant pre and post project data and information in regards to the ESL Pilot Project.
