Non-Recurring Payment (NRP)

Veteran Full-time Staff

Cost of \$ 475,000

(Step 25 for FY25)

- *\$1,000 for certified staff;*
- *\$750 for classified staff and administrators*

All Full-time Staff

Cost of \$3,075,000

(in addition to the NRP above)

- *\$1,250 for all full-time staff*

More Unknowns

Teacher Minimum Salary Raise (TMSR) Fund

- *Will it continue to fund FSPS salary & benefits?*

This appears to be safe for now.

Full implementation of voucher system in Arkansas

- *What's the impact to student enrollment?*

Still unknown.

Citizen's Committee Report

- *Will we continue our path of right-sizing the District?*

Still unknown.
