Maintenance board Report 2.26.25

The new high school woodshop is close to completed, with only a few smaller items that are being finished up. Once everything is completed there will be a walk-through punch list to ensure that everything in working properly. Schmolk mechanical will be training on the operation of the dust collector unit and any other mechanical operated equipment installed. Everything from the old shop has been moved over to the new woodshop and it will take time to go organize everything, get it set up and any new storage built.

In the old woodshop we removed all the old dust collector unit and pipping and the majority of all the 220v drops and any other electrical that will not be needed. Preparation to making this location the new weight room, we have ordered new rubber weight room flooring, and it should be arriving in a few weeks.

The new high school dishwasher should be getting shipped with in the next week or two. It is a big thanks to Jackie for spearheading this to get the best deal and a small rebait for the district.

Sports transportation for the past few weeks kept us busy, bussing high school basketball teams to and from IFA the weekend of the 18th of January and bussing teams to and from the IFA for the Craig high School Cultural Tournament, 23rd through 25th of January. The 7th through the 9th of February we bussed teams for the middle school hosted wrestling tournament and the Skagway basketball team that same weekend. The 14th of February we dropped off a van at Island Air for an incoming Itinerant and picked up the van from Is. Air on the 24th. The 19th and the 22nd we bussed Haines basketball team to and from the IFA. The morning of the 21st we dropped off a van at the IFA for the returning ACDC team.

For a few weeks most of our time throughout the district was spent pushing snow, shoveling snow and spreading ice melt.

The middle school fuel tank is on a keep full list with Petro marine. We ran out of fuel on the Monday morning the 10^{th} and Petro Marine came right out and filled the tank. We were scheduled for refuel on the 13^{th} , but with that cold snap the boilers were running more keeping up with the demands for heat.

We worked on the staff housing electrical replacing a GFI in the kitchen and two 20amp breakers.

On the buses we changed out the internal transmission filter along with transmission fluid. Greased the chassis and breaks. Next month we are performing our quarterly bus inspections.

I have been working on a tentative FY 25/26 budget, working of the board approved amount that was approved for this school year.

The Head Start building had a few pipes freeze during the few weeks of freezing weather. The pipes were thawed and nothing, thankfully was broke.

When time allows the maintenance department has been working on teacher maintenance requests and any other maintenance needs as they come up.
