SUMMARY OF OVERRIDE DEVELOPMENTS

- × 10% of our Maintenance and Operations Budget
- Originally passed in 2005; renewed in 2009 and 2014
- Allows us to continue to address issues first presented to the voters in 2005

OVERRIDE CATEGORIES:

- × Class size reduction
- × Elementary art, music, p.e.
- × Electives at the middle school level
- AP, IB, and Cambridge programs at the high schools
- × Academic intervention
- × Facilities and technology staff
- Attracting and maintaining staff

OVERRIDE BUDGET

- Funds depend on our Maintenance and Operations Budget (M & O)
- × 10% of total M & O
- × First year: \$7,077,656
- × Highest amount: \$8,026,688
- × Current year: (estimated) \$6,911,488
- Difference between highest and current: \$1,115,200

CLASS SIZE REDUCTION

- Kern Harsh budgetary cuts of the past several years, we have worked to help keep class sizes as low as possible.
- Some issues are difficult to resolve because of scheduling and other related issues.
- * At the elementary level, primary class sizes are targeted.
- × Last year, 30 positions; this year, 31

ELEMENTARY ART, MUSIC AND P.E.

- Prior to the 2005 passage of the override, classes varied from site to site.
- With the passage of the override, all elementary schools offer increased time per week in art, music, and p.e. to students.
- Classes are taught by specialists in those fields.

ELECTIVES AT THE MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Classes originally funded by override funding include:
 - +STEM classes
 - +Odyssey of the Mind
 - + Computer Programming
 - +Spanish Level I at La Cima and AMS

AP, IB, AND CAMBRIDGE COURSES

- * Amphi has built a strong Advanced Placement course selection for students
- * AP courses available have gone from 10 to 27 during the last 10 years.
- × IB program is supported at CDO
- Cambridge program is supported at AHS
- × Internship programs remain in place

INTERVENTION PROGRAMS

- All schools can apply for before school and after-school tutoring funds targeting students for academic support.
- Intervention options are not limited to remedial programs; for example, accelerated math options were used by a number of schools, and book study groups are in place.
- Sometimes interventions can occur during the day.

SUPPORT FOR FACILITIES/TECHNOLOGY

- Funds are used to support an HVAC position at facilities.
- Funds are used to support a technology position.

ATTRACT AND MAINTAIN STAFF

* A portion of all our employees' salaries is paid for with override funds.
