As per Chapter 61, School Districts; Subchapter A., Board of Trustees Relationship; TAC 61.61(j), "Annually, at the meeting at which the call for election of board members is normally scheduled, the current president of each board member who has completed the required continuing education, who has exceeded their required hours of continuing education and who is deficient in the required continuing education. The president shall cause the minutes of the information available to the local media". In compliance with the above the following statement should be read by the Board President;

ANNOUNCEMENT:

State law requires that:

1. In a board member's first year of service, he or she shall receive at least ten hours of continuing education in fulfillment of assessed needs.
2. Following a board member's first year of service, he or she shall receive at least five hours of continuing education annually in fulfillment of assessed needs.
3. A board president shall receive continuing education related to leadership duties of a board president as some portion of the annual requirement.

As Board President, I am advising all members of the Board of the above requirement and would like the minutes to reflect the board members which require additional training before the Nov. 2, 2010 school board election.
