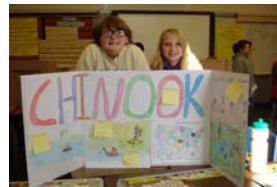
- ⇒ **PTO:** Evergreen Parent Teacher Organization needs volunteers. If you are interested inquire at the office

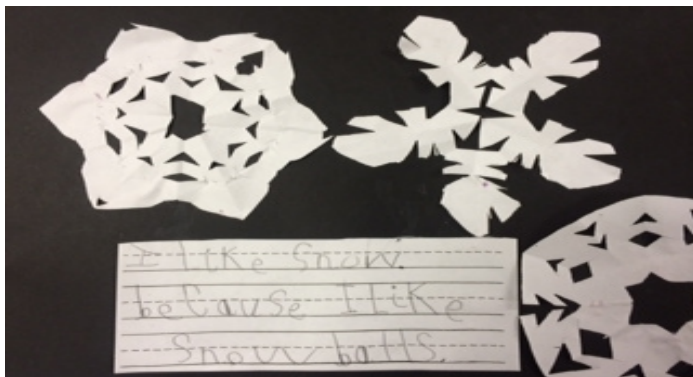
Mrs. Griffis's 5th Grade Class

Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age.
