<b>Basic information:</b>
As of December 8, 2025, we have been in school for 68 days, and the districtwide chronic absenteeism rate is at 16%, which is an increase from last month.
Students missing 10% or more of the school days are considered chronically absent. These percentages include both excused and unexcused absences. Please see the following charts for a breakdown by grade level bands as well as each grade level.
School attendance teams continue to meet in each school. Assistant principals are working with the teams to track and monitor student attendance at the building level. The teams are actively working with monitoring the attendance, informing families if there is an attendance concern, and taking the time to support families as needed so students can come to school each day. They also continue to implement school-wide attendance incentives to promote perfect attendance.
<b>Background or historical information:</b>
Our school report cards were published on October 30, 2025. According to the Illinois School Report Card, District 33 had a chronic absenteeism rate of 18.7%, compared to the state average of 25.4%. Our truancy rate was 11.8% whereas the state average was 19.8%.
