Re: H.S. Competitive Gym Floor Sand and Refinish

I am recommending and seeking approval to award the sanding, painting and refinishing of all three high school competition gym floors to Foster Specialty Floors. This project will be financed through the Sinking Fund.

This work and pricing are listed on the Sourcewell Purchasing Consortium (formerly NJPA). The cost to complete all three floors is \$96,006.42. A cost breakdown is listed below:

Cost per square foot for this scope of work and listed products is \$2.46.
