### CONSENT ITEM

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Board approve the selection of Yates Company, LLC. to provide general contractor services for the RFCSP 25-02 Districtwide MEP (Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing) Package III project in Bond 2022 and that the Board of Trustees delegate the authority to the Superintendent to execute all contracts and related documents necessary to complete this project. The scope of work includes but is not limited to providing all general construction work (site work, HVAC, electrical, plumbing, etc.) as indicated in the contract documents for six (6) facilities; Millers Point ES, Olympia ES, Park Village ES, Paschall ES, Rolling Meadows ES, and Salinas ES. HVAC controls will be upgraded at all six (6) campuses with interior lighting upgrades at Millers Point ES, Park Village ES, and Paschall ES and boiler replacements at Millers Point ES, Park Village ES, and Salinas ES. Expenditures will be made from Bond 2022 funds at a total estimated cost of \$7,292,888.00.

#### **IMPACT/RATIONALE:**

Allows the district to purchase goods and services in accordance with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code. Expenditures will be made from Bond 2022 funds at a total estimated cost of \$7,292,888.00. The scope of work includes but is not limited to providing all general construction work (site work, HVAC, electrical, plumbing, etc.) as indicated in the contract documents for six (6) facilities; Millers Point ES, Olympia ES, Park Village ES, Paschall ES, Rolling Meadows ES, and Salinas ES. HVAC controls will be upgraded at all six (6) campuses with interior lighting upgrades at Millers Point ES, Park Village ES, and Paschall ES and boiler replacements at Millers Point ES, Park Village ES, and Salinas ES. Yates Company, LLC. is the highest ranked general contractor for the RFCSP 25-02 Districtwide MEP (Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing) Package III project.

The scope of work includes but is not limited to providing all general construction work (site work, HVAC, electrical, plumbing, etc.) as indicated in the contract documents for six (6) facilities; Millers Point ES, Olympia ES, Park Village ES, Paschall ES, Rolling Meadows ES, and Salinas ES. HVAC controls will be upgraded at all six (6) campuses with interior lighting upgrades at Millers Point ES, Park Village ES, and Paschall ES and boiler replacements at Millers Point ES, Park Village ES, and Salinas ES.

The total estimated construction cost is \$7,292,888.00. This includes the base proposal, Alternates #E2.1 – E4.1, #M1.1 – M7.2, and owner contingency.

Alternate #E2.1 has been recommended and is for the replacement and installation of light fixtures and associated lighting controls at the gymnasium and classrooms at Millers Point ES.

Alternates #E3.1 and E3.2 have been recommended and are for the replacement and installation of light fixtures and associated lighting controls in central and south classrooms at Park Village ES.

Alternate #E4.1 has been recommended and is for the replacement and installation of light fixtures and associated lighting controls in the cafeteria and classroom at Paschall ES.

Alternates #M2.1 and M2.2 have been recommended and are for the replacement of the existing pneumatic valve actuators, installation of new motorized actuators and replacement of the existing hydronic control valves at Millers Point ES.

Alternates #M3.1 and M3.2 have been recommended and are for the replacement of the existing pneumatic valve actuators, installation of new motorized actuators and replacement of the existing hydronic control valves at Park Village ES.

Alternates #M4.1 and M4.2 have been recommended and are for the replacement of the existing pneumatic valve actuators, installation of new motorized actuators and replacement of the existing hydronic control valves at Paschall ES.

Alternates #M5.1 and M5.2 have been recommended and are for the replacement of the existing pneumatic valve actuators, installation of new motorized actuators and replacement of the existing hydronic control valves at Salinas ES.

Alternates #M6.1 and M6.2 have been recommended and are for the replacement of the existing pneumatic valve actuators, installation of new motorized actuators and replacement of the existing hydronic control valves at Rolling Meadows ES.

Alternates #M7.1 and M7.2 have been recommended and are for the replacement of the existing pneumatic valve actuators, installation of new motorized actuators and replacement of the existing hydronic control valves at Olympia ES.
