The State Board of Education (SBOE) voted on November 22, 2024, to approve the tier-one full- and partial-subject instructional materials list for Instructional Materials Review and Approval Cycle 2024. Each of the full-subject instructional materials were found to meet 100% of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and applicable English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS).


