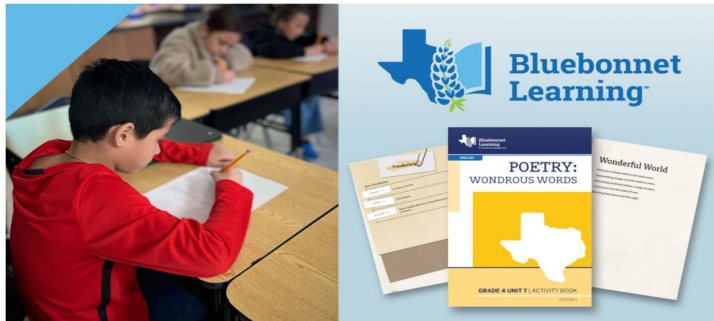

**50%** of grant funds to contract with a single provider from the LASO Cycle 3 state approved vendor list to provide core services of the grant.

**20%** of grant funds for additional support from the Approved Provider and/or salaries or partial salaries for instructional coaches or other positions directly supporting implementation of the instructional materials

**30%** of grant funds for other allowable expenses (e.g., print materials, digital licenses, assessment licenses, instructional coaches)

# Utilization of Grant Funds



LEAs will select one Approved Provider for both types of supports



Supports for LASO Cycle 3 are updated from previous cycles based on stakeholder feedback



LEAs will select ONE Approved Provider for both implementation and product supports for their **implementation content(s)**. We recommend that LEAs work with one AP across all grant areas, but it is allowable to have separate APs for different contents.



ESC 20 is being recommended as our selected approved provider for the support and implementation of the Bluebonnet K-5 Reading Language Arts materials.
