 - Social Services Clerk



Financial Audit Information

Federal

- The last Head Start fiscal monitoring was in 2012 and it was free of any fiscal findings.
- Due to the new regulations and guidelines, Head Start program components and financial audit are now performed separately.
- Head Start did not conduct any fiscal monitoring of the Denton ISD Head Start program in 2018-2019.

Local

- Denton ISD conducts an annual financial audit that includes review of all federal funding. The last one was completed in November of 2018 with no material findings.
- The audit for 2018-2019 is currently being conducted with a scheduled completion date of November 2019.
