DESCRIPTION:

The current curriculum adoption process in K-12 math programming for BHM Schools is taking place over a multi-year period of time due to the updates in state academic standards in math and the timing of course implementations. Last year, Curriculum Adoption Proposals were approved for Grades 6-8 Math, as well as Algebra, Geometry and Statistics. This year, the focus of the addendum is Trigonometry and Financial Algebra. Next year, the final adoption stages of K-5 Math and Calculus will complete the adoption cycle.

The Trigonometry and Financial Algebra teachers have engaged in the district Continuous Improvement Process (CIP) review tasks over the past two years in the RESEARCH and PILOT phases. They have been active in activities that have included:

- review of national standards
- o discussions of preferred resources and development of resource scenarios
- consensus-building to reach recommendation decisions

These tasks have now culminated into the Curriculum Adoption Addendum for review at this time.
