Management of Food Services

(This is covered in policy EFAA and its administrative regulation, EFAA-AR.)

The district may provide food services for students and staff. Food services will comply with state and federal laws and regulations relating to such services.

The executive administrator for business under the direction of the assistant superintendent for support services, will be responsible for the management of the food service program.

The district's food services program shall be self-supporting. Any subsidies shall not include local tax dollars.

The executive administrator for business will report to the Board any financial condition changes/forecasts in the food service program and will make such other reports related to food services as the Board requests. The food service program financial reports shall be included in the annual audit and comprehensive financial report for the district.

Sale of Non-Nutritious Food

The Board supports the concept of the school meal program as a nutritional needs program.

In association with the USDA regulations for federally supported meal programs, the school district will promote the school meal program in its various schools and encourage students to participate. However, competitive foods of minimal nutritional value may be sold outside the food service area during the breakfast and/or lunch periods or at other times during the school day. These foods may also be offered (not sold) in the district's offer vs. serve program with lunch or breakfast using funds other than food service funds.

Funds received from the sale of such foods will accrue to the appropriate program as determined by the executive administrator for business.
