
STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM REPLACEMENT

POLICY ISSUE/SITUATION:

The contract between the Oregon Student Information System Consortium (OSIS) and EduPoint has been finalized. The Beaverton School District will soon begin planning the replacement of the current student information system (eSIS) with the EduPoint Synergy student information system.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In November 2010, the Beaverton School District was notified that Administrative Assistants Limited (AAL), the current student information system vendor, was purchased and eSIS would no longer remain a supported product after June 30, 2012.

The Beaverton School District, along with a number of other school districts and ESDs, formed a consortium to collectively seek a replacement student information system. This process concluded in February 2012 with the EduPoint Synergy product selected as the replacement student information system.

While the current vendor has extended support until June 2013, Beaverton School District must now begin the transition to the new student information system.

The Synergy suite has a number of features that could positively impact students, parents, and staff. Some key modules include:

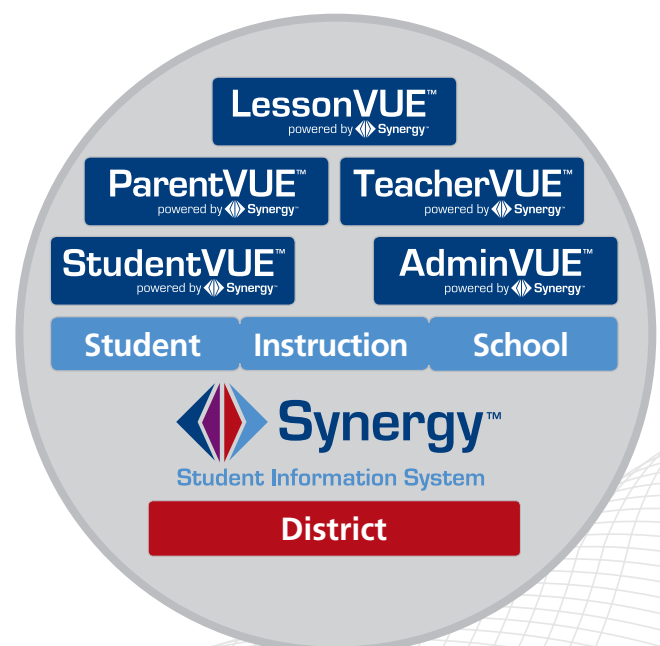

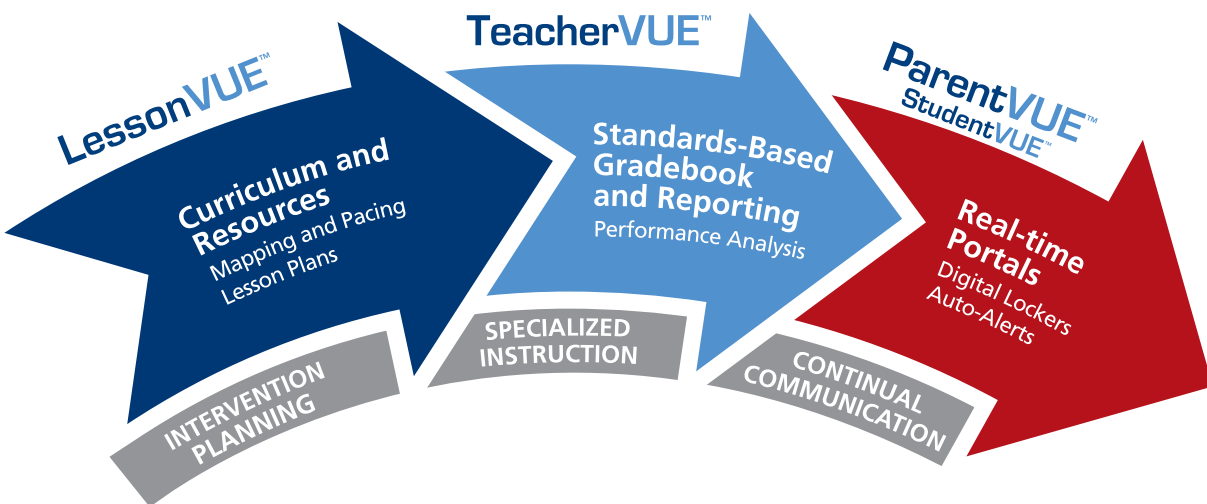
