REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:

Board review is required for new programs that are submitted to the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities for approval.

BACKGROUND:

On October 1, 2024 BOLI-approved the Child Care Development Specialist Apprenticeship in coordination with the Willamette Valley Early Learning JATC. According to the Oregon Employment Department, there is a growing demand for individuals with early learning credentials in Clackamas County, Oregon. Mid-Willamette Valley Community Action Agency has chosen to work with CCC to offer the new apprenticeship under the title *Child Care Specialist Apprenticeship*.

BUDGET IMPACT/SOURCE OF FUNDS:

Current remote student services can support the Child Care Specialist Apprenticeship Certificate of Completion. Courses will be offered on-site in Salem at the Mid-Willamette Valley Community Action Agency (MWVCAA) office. MWVCAA will be funding the apprenticeship courses that are part of this new certificate of completion.
