## District Administrator's Report

June 2023

### State Track

Congratulations to the Girls 4x100 Relay Team that competed at the State Track and Field Championships on June 2. The team of Natalie Schommer, Maggie Wooten, Kendall Lillehaug, Kally Svoboda, Desi Hughes, and Amelia Kelch ran in the preliminary heats on Friday. The team finished in 14th out of 16 state qualifiers.



### Summer Projects

A number of facility projects will be scattered throughout the summer. Carl is working closely with the contractors to schedule the following:

- Elementary gymnasium and Performance Center painting, along with the elementary skylights
- Sidewalk section replacement at both schools
- IP Clock and Speaker Installation
- Outdoor activity area at the middle school and Roots and Branches
- Classroom door installation and vestibule safety window install
- Parking lot sealing and lines
- Window safety film

### Summer School

Our June summer school programming is rolling with opportunities and participation. Our programming continues to be an attraction and we keep working hard to expand the offerings. We know there is always room to improve and capture the attention of our students.

### District Budget Planning

Progress is happening with the biennial budget, with legislators engaged in discussions and proposals. This is a good sign and hopefully we will know more in the coming days, not weeks or months. In closing our 2022-23 budget cycle, we are working to determine the amount necessary for our fund 27, special education transfer, and an amount we can transfer to fund 46, our capital improvement fund. So as we wrap up the current year, we are already ordering materials for next year, primarily classroom and curricular supplies.



### Transitions

As our staff transitions to new positions, Ms. Kline (6-12 Principal) has been working in the district a few days already. We worked with Unity to purchase eight days in June. Ms. Hansford is transitioning to her new role (Director of Instruction) and has been laying out a scope of work and doing research on instructional best practices with our instructional materials. Ms. Richter (Interventionist/Reading Specialist) will be familiarizing herself with the district's reading, Title 1, and RtI plans.

### State Inspection

The state inspector visited Roots and Branches last week and provided many compliments on how thorough our record keeping is, how clean the facility is, and how we are obviously set up with the children's best interests in mind. The inspector acknowledged our staff incorporates a lot of developmentally appropriate learning activities for our children.

### District Audit

Our district audit comes a little earlier this year. Two Rivers Accounting will be here the week of July 10 to review our financials and then we'll continue to work with them through the summer and fall to complete the entire process.
