

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding made between the Mid-Valley Executive Advisory Board of the Mid-Valley Special Education Cooperative (MVSEC) (hereinafter referred to as the 'Employer' or 'Board') and the Therapy Association for Special Children, IEA-NEA (hereinafter referred to as the 'Association') will add a mentoring program stipend to the current Collective Bargaining Agreement for one year as described below.

WHEREAS, the Association and Board ratified the current Collective Bargaining Agreement of 2013-2015 resolving all issues relative to the current Agreement between the parties.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the parties have bargained in good faith and mutually agree to add a mentoring program stipend with no other changes to existing contract language with the exception of the addition of the attached language for the 2015-2016 school year.

This Memorandum of Understanding will expire on June 30, 2016.
