Goal - Collaboration with staff and students [and families] to make sure everyone feels safe.

- 1. Structures for reporting COVID-related safety concerns:
 - Elementary level students: Regular check-ins regarding safety and inviting 1:1 interaction (we have resources from Thrive regarding helping students talk about COVID-related issues)
 - Middle school level students: Google form for reporting concerns submit to a chosen trusted adult
 - Staff: Create flow chart outlining where to go with custodial concerns, larger safety issues, and health questions
 - Parents: Follow existing pathways, emailing classroom teachers for classroom concerns, building principals for building-wide concerns
- 2. Structures for reporting social emotional concerns
 - Elementary level: Regular check-ins regarding safety + inviting 1:1 interaction (we have resources from Thrive regarding helping students talk about COVID)
 - Middle school level: Google form for reporting concerns submit to a chosen trusted adult
 - Staff: Create a flow chart of resources (health insurance, building social workers, THRIVE, etc.)
 - Parents: Follow existing pathways, emailing classroom teachers to report problems and access student supports
- 3. Guidance updates on standards and use in D90 (also on communication plan)
 - Post short video presentations on social emotional resources for families
 - Maintain COVID panel page on District website after school reopening to provide a dedicated place for safety updates and information
