Item Title: Approval of Student Outcome Goal Progress Measures and Constraint Progress Measures for 2017-18 Superintendent's Evaluation

Description:

For 2017-18, the Superintendent's performance will be measured on the progress made on the Goal Progress Measures (GPM) and the Constraint Progress Measures (CPM). A student outcome goal or constraint is considered met if a) the goal actual results meet or exceed the target or b) at least 2/3rd of the respective Goal Progress Measure (GPM) or Constraint Progress Measure (CPM) actual results meet or exceed the targets. Overall Superintendent performance is met if at least 4/5th of the goals and constraints are met.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board adopt the student outcome goal progress measures and constraint progress measures for the 2017-18 Superintendent's Evaluation.

District Goal/Strategy:

Goal 1 The percentage of graduates who will qualify for community college/university, military, or industry certification will increase from 62% to 85% for graduating class of 2022.

Goal 2 The percent of students who perform at the Masters Grade Level standard for all grades in state mathematics exams will increase from 8% to 40% by 2022.

Goal 3 The percent of students who perform at the Masters Grade Level standard for all grades in state reading exams will increase from 9% to 40% by 2022.

Superintendent Evaluation Template

Because Superintendent performance is considered indistinguishable from District performance, the Superintendent's annual evaluation is simply the amalgam of all monthly monitoring reports. A student outcome goal or constraint is considered met if a) the goal actual results meet or exceed the target or b) at least 2/3rd of the respective goal progress measure (GMP) or constraint progress measure (CPM) actual results meet or exceed the targets. Overall Superintendent performance is met if at least 4/5ths of the goals and constraints are met.
