BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Every other year the Potter-Randall Appraisal District goes through an election process for their board of directors. The schedule of the election process is attached. Step one is the Chief Appraiser giving notice of the number of votes that each district has. We have received this notice which indicates RRISD has 135 of the 5,000 votes in Potter County. Step two is for the governing body to submit nominations for Board of Director positions (this is the step we are currently at.) A listing of the current Board of Directors and their willingness to serve another term is also attached. Step three is for the governing body to submit their votes for the various nominees (which will be done between November 1 and December 15.)
