### **3-6 Classroom: S. Weekes**

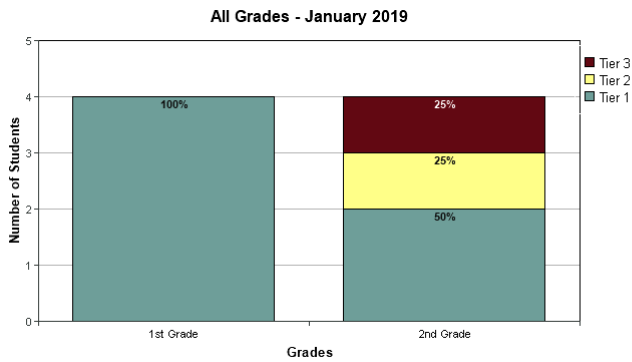

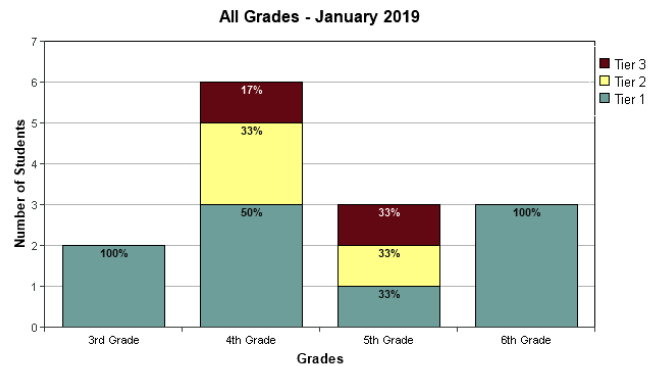
