BUILDINGS/GROUNDS

Facilities Committee

The Facilities Committee met Wednesday, September 20th. Minutes of the meeting are attached with this month's Board Report. The next meeting is scheduled for 5:30 p.m., Wednesday, January 10, 2018 to be held at the Pana Jr. High School.

Phase 2 Project Update

- **Sr. High**
 - Exterior painting is 100% complete at the Sr. High.
- **Jr. High**
 - The stairwells of the band and auditorium rooms have been painted.
 - Exterior work 100% complete.
- **Lincoln School**
 - All work 100% complete.
- **Washington School**
 - All work is 100% complete.

Annual Crisis Management Review

The district's annual crisis management review took place on September 7th. A copy of those minutes are attached to this month's board report.

High School Track

As previously reported, repairs will be made in November. A follow-up inspection will take place in February in case further repairs need to be made prior to start of track season.

Water/Lead Testing

The water testing was completed September 12-14. I do not have test results back as of the date of this report.

Phase 3 Projects

Mr. Bauer has asked me to make contact with GRP to set up a meeting in November/December to review the next phase of possible projects. The strategic plan that was updated in January, 2017 was reviewed with the Facilities Committee at our most recent meeting.

Windows for Press Box

I received a phone call from Al Stupek regarding the installation of more windows in the football press box. His concern is that there is very limited seating to view the entire length of the field from inside the press box. He added that there may already be a couple of groups/individuals willing to help fund this project. I told him I would bring to the board, and if approved to move forward, I would get bids for this project.

TRANSPORTATION

Annual State Report

The report for Fiscal '17, payable in Fiscal '18 was completed in August. The state figured reimbursement at 100% for this year vs. figuring only at 71% for regular and vocational transportation, and 91% for special education transportation for the previous year. This increase in percentage doesn't necessarily mean we will receive the entire reimbursement due to the district. Last year, we received two of the four scheduled payments, and one of last year's payments was received in this fiscal year (August). Mr. Bauer & Heather have budgeted for the last FY '17 payment and one FY '18 payment.
