Fall Programs

Our fall programming is in full swing, and we’re excited to continue expanding our offerings. Alongside returning favorites like NFL Flag Football, Fall Dance Team, Mini Me Dance, and 5th/6th Grade Tackle Football, we’re introducing new opportunities this season. Zach Kantor and the tennis coaching staff are running a Fall Tennis Camp for students grades 4-6. We have 21 players participating in this program.
