**ITEM: VII.H.**

**TOPIC:           Approval of Bid Results for Bus Purchase – 2013 Bond**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of thirteen mini buses (A-2) from Midwest Transit Equipment, Marshall, Michigan for a cost of \$644,072.00; and eight 77-passenger long body conventional buses plus three 72-passenger conventional special needs buses from Holland Bus Company, Holland, Michigan for a cost of \$985,059.00. The combined total of this proposed purchase of 24 buses is \$1,629,131.00.

**RATIONALE:**

This purchase of the 24 buses is a planned purchase in order to update the Transportation department fleet.

**BUDGETARY INFORMATION:**

The source of funds for these purchases will be the 2013 Bond Fund.
