Discussion & Darrell Muncy, Director of Student Services along with Judge Joe Holland, Review of and Judge Ramsey of the Denton Municipal Court which deals with high school students explained the Compulsory Attendance Law and some of the Compulsory most misunderstood components, thus leading to court action for parents and Attendance students. Under IDEA, Texas Education Agency is required to make annual determination of the District's performance based on several categories: Performance on State Performance Plan (SPP) compliance indicators 9, 10,11, 12 and 13, Submission of valid, reliable, and timely data, Uncorrected noncompliance from other sources (complaints resolution, due process, and monitoring), Any financial findings, Performance-Based Monitoring (PBM) Stage of Intervention, Significant Disproportionality. (Due to the change in methodology, this data element will not be included in the 2013 Determination Process. Denton ISD received the 2013 Local Education Agency (LEA) Determination status of "Meets Requirements".

Summer School Report	Dr. Mike Mattingly, Asst. Superintendent for Curriculum & Instruction provided the Board of Trustees an update on the outcomes of the 2013 Denton ISD Summer School Program, including Bilingual/ESL and Secondary.
	The report shares information regarding 2013 Extended School Year (ESY) services for students with disabilities. Federal funds were used to provide services for eligible students. The intent of the program is to provide students who have lost skills during the traditional school year an opportunity to regain those skills. The provision of ESY is enforced through Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) (34 CFR Part 300). Specifically, §300.309, §300.340-§300.350 extended school year services and §300.24 related services. A student's need for ESY is determined by the admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee. Eligibility is based on documentation that regression has occurred in a critical skill area. The data demonstrates that the child was not able to recoup lost skills within eight weeks of returning from summer break or two to three weeks after returning from a 7-14 day break.
