AGENDA ITEM: 2017-2018 Aledo ISD Calendar

ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S): Learning ~ District will provide an aligned, rigorous curriculum, with instructional / technology programs preparing students to meet / exceed all educational standards.

Background Information: House Bill 2610 replaced the 180 days of instruction per calendar school year with the requirement of at least 75,600 minutes of instruction, including intermissions and recess.

Three calendars were developed and presented for consideration to the District Wide Effectiveness Improvement Committee (DWEIC). The DWEIC presented proposed calendars to their respective campus for feedback and approval. Calendar A received 0 votes, calendar B received 5 votes, and calendar C received 4 votes.

Staff shared the following reasons for their selection of calendar B:

- Additional student day
- Banking three bad weather days
- Half week for exams in December
- December holiday equally split for separated families
