Board Report

<u>College Applications</u> – all seniors who plan on attending college have completed or are in the process of completing applications

- o Currently 10 students graduating on the Foundation Plan, the rest will graduate with an Endorsement (required to attend a 4-year college program)
- o 2 Students enlisting in Service
- o 17 students accepted/attending 4-year college
- o 14 students accepted/attending a junior/community college
- o 4 students plan to work
- o 3 Junior students graduating early

<u>Scholarships</u> - Students were given a packet with list of local scholarships. Mrs. Fambrough went through the list and helped students know which scholarships they would qualify to apply for (to lessen the stress of figuring it all out).

- o The first round of scholarships were due on April 5, next round due April 25.
- \circ All scholarship applications are turned into the QHS office, and will be turned into the organization.
- Some scholarships will be decided by a committee at the high school (Mr. James and 2-3 teachers from the site-base committee).

Senior Meetings – Mrs. Fambrough met one on one with each Senior last month to review transcript, graduation plan, ensure college applications were complete or in the process of being completed. Each senior student received a folder with a Senior To-Do list, specific for that student of "things to still complete." In the folder was also a copy of the student's transcript, TEA Graduation toolkit packet.

Graduation Plans

Mrs. Fambrough will be meeting with all students in grades 9, 10, 11 the week of April 16 (when this first round of STAAR testing is complete) to discuss graduation plans and endorsements. Students will start to choose courses for next year.

State Testing -

- o STAAR Alt Window opened on April 2, will close on April 20
- o STAAR/EOC first round of STAAR and EOC is next week:
 - Tuesday 4-10 4th/7th Writing STAAR, 5th/8th Math STAAR, English I EOC
 - Wednesday 4-11 5th/8th Reading STAAR
 - Thursday 4-12 English II EOC
- o Next STAAR testing window
 - Week of May 7 Biology EOC, Algebra I EOC and US History EOC
 - Week of May 14
 - 5-14 Grades 3, 4, 6, 7 Math STAAR, Grades 5/8 Math retest
 - 5-15 Grades 3, 4, 6, 7, Reading STAAR, Grades 5/8 Rdg retest
 - 5-16 Grades 5/8 Science STAAR
 - 5-17 Grade 8 Social Studies STAAR
 - Summer STAAR students in grades 5 and 8 who do not pass the Reading or Math STAAR test will be required to attend summer school and retest (June 26 Math, June 27 Reading). EOC failures will also be required to attend summer school and retest (June 25 English I, June 27 English II, Biology/US History/Algebra I week of June 25)

<u>NHS</u> – Students who are in NHS are required to acquire 10 hours of community service. Some students have already completed their hours and turned in the documentation, these are due by the end of April.
