Board Report

February 2026

- Student assessment accommodations are being reviewed and submitted to the Illinois Administration Platform in preparation for all spring assessments: Illinois Assessment of Readiness and Illinois Science Assessment (Grades 3-8). These accommodations are discussed at all students' IEP and 504 meetings throughout the year. Vicky is working with elementary building level administrators to create proctor groups and to plan proctor training opportunities.
- Vicky Mudd and Kati Gotto attended an ISBE hosted workshop in Mt.Vernon on Feb 2nd. This workshop reviewed the state requirements regarding Early Childhood Outcomes which entail special education case managers submitting student progress at enrollment, exit, and annually. Vicky and Kati then met with the EC/PK team on Feb 13th to share the information. The team will be adjusting assessment documentation practices to ensure that requirements are met while maximizing student learning.
- On Feb 13th, paraprofessionals participated in professional development provided by Sarah Brennfleck with Perandoe focusing on trauma informed practices.
- Additionally on Feb 13th, all special education teachers attended a 3 hour workshop focusing on writing clear, measurable, and appropriate IEP goals and objectives. Data-collection methods for effective progress monitoring was also presented.
