## Attendance Report – Cycle 1

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### Board Goal

#### IV. Parent and Community Involvement

In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

### Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the first grading cycle (August 24, 2015 – October 2, 2015).

### Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 29 days (August 24 – October 2).

### Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

### Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 1 is 97.12%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12<sup>th</sup> graders at 95.40% followed by 11<sup>th</sup> graders at 95.62%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade at 97.92% followed by 3<sup>rd</sup> grade at 97.80%.
- Comparison:       2014's first grading cycle was 97.17%  
                              2013's first grading cycle was 97.27%  
                              2012's first grading cycle was 97.44%.
