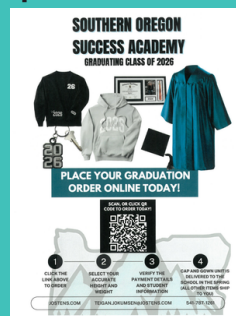
Join Us for Family Literacy Night!
