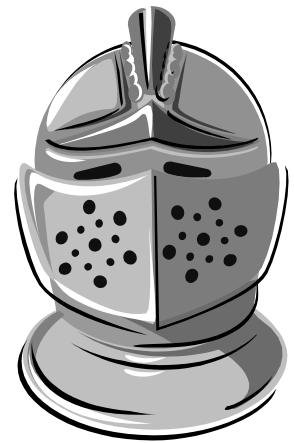


FALL MUSIC CONCERT

FROM MR. PLATT.....

Please check the counseling office for upcoming college visitations. There will be an OUS Campus Visitation on Wednesday, October 10th. Andy Goldner will also have the information for students interested in attending the National College Fair in Medford. We have sent a bus with NVHS students each year.

The Oregon University System will have representatives from all of the State Universities at NVHS on Wednesday, October 10th. Senior and Junior students interested in attending a four year college will have an opportunity to meet with college admissions personnel.

PSAT TESTING

The PSAT test will be given at NVHS on Wednesday, October 17. The test will start during the beginning of the day, and run about three hours in duration. All NVHS 10th grade students will take the test (their test has been paid for by the state.) All other students (the test is geared for 11th grade students) must sign up for the test and pay the testing fee (\$15) for NVHS students, or home school students requesting to test.

Space is limited; as we order enough tests for our 10 grade class and estimated 11th grade testers, along with a few seats for GPHS students who cannot take the Saturday PSAT. We usually have one or two home school students who participate. We are fined if we order excessive tests.

Grants Pass High School is also offering the PSAT, their test date is Saturday, October 20th. They charge \$23 for the test.
