


Beginning of Year Istation Grades K-5 ENGLISH

- Hutchins 3rd Grade--69% Tier 1 (English and Spanish combined)

Data Analysis--Elementary Areas of Focus by Grade

- Kindred and Carrillo, both IR campuses, have a high number of Tier 3 students in several grade levels.
 - o Both campuses have hired additional staff to provide targeted interventions to Tier 3 students.
 - Both campuses have an instructional coach dedicated to reading support.
- Armstrong 3rd Grade Tier 3--31% (22 students)
- Benavidez 5th Grade Tier 3--29% (30 students)
- Five Palms 1st Grade Tier 3--40% (24 students)
- Hutchins 5th Grade Tier 3--33% (30 students)
- Madla 2nd Grade Tier 3--31% (17 students)
- Palo Alto Kinder Tier 3--41% (25 students)
- Price 5th Grade Tier 3--25% (23 students)

Data Analysis--Elementary

- Teachers in grades K-3 are providing guided reading on students' instructional reading level daily to Tier 3 students and those students are being progress monitored weekly.
- Reading teachers, paraprofessionals, and additional staff are trained to provide additional intervention to Tier 3 students using the Leveled Literacy Intervention kits.
- Students are on their customized Istation pathway weekly for their required amount of time:
 - o Tier 1 = 30 minutes
 - Tier 2 = 60 minutes
 - Tier 3 = 90 minutes

Middle School Reading Support

- All three campuses are using Exact Path, an online customized pathway created from each student's MAP data, to intervene or accelerate students.
- Dwight MS has two 6th grade reading intervention classes where students are receiving a combination of face to face and customized online interventions.
- Shepard MS has reading intervention classes for each grade level where teachers are using Scholastic Short Reads to conduct small group instruction during class. Shepard also has small group pullouts.
- Zamora MS has a reading intervention class for each grade level where students are receiving a combination of face to face and customized online interventions.
