

Item #1: Materials

1. All Owner Supplied Materials must be shipped by March 31st 2026
2. All Owner Supplied Materials can be stored on site in Pahrump, and at the North District Office in Tonopah
3. Contractor supplied materials required to be purchased from Garland for the Full System Warranty, must have a PO submitted to Garland by December 22nd 2025 and shipped by March 31 2026 to receive 2025 pricing. Contractor can choose to wait and not purchase until later, contractor to add an estimated 3%-5% upcharge, this is an estimate and price may be higher. Contractor is responsible for any 2026 upcharge as the 2026 pricing is not published yet

Item #2: 601 E Calvada Blvd, Pahrump NV – Maintenance Office

1. Contractor to remove and dispose of all abandoned penetrations that were marked with RED paint at the job walk, infill with polyiso insulation to proper height
2. Contractor to fill flutes with polyiso insulation
3. Contractor to properly flash all penetrations
4. Contractor to install all new rubber sleepers

Item #3: 601 E Calvada Blvd, Pahrump NV – Maintenance Warehouse – Area 51

1. Contractor to remove and dispose of all abandoned penetrations that were marked with RED paint at the job walk, infill with polyiso insulation to proper height
2. Contractor to install all new thru wall scuppers and downspouts
3. Contractor to increase the size of the existing crickets to ensure water drains to through wall scuppers, ponding water is cause for rejection
4. Contractor to install pitch pockets at all brackets and uni-struts
5. Contractor to install all new rubber sleepers


Item #4: Pathways

1. Contractor to install the membrane up and over all interior walls
2. Contractor to install all new rubber sleepers
3. Remove to remove and dispose of all abandoned penetrations that were marked with RED paint at the job walk, infill with polyiso insulation to proper height.
4. Install all new metal flashing
5. On all flashing that require a termination bar, the contractor is to install sealant behind the term bar, caulking above the term bar
6. Contractor to paint all gas lines per code and color
7. Contractor to re-caulk all ducting that is mounted to the stucco wall and coat all seams and any holes.
8. Contractor to coat all HVAC ducting seams and pan seam
9. ALL roof section of the Pathways building are to be re-roofed and included in the contractors bid. The 219 sq foot roof in the included Eagle View in the SE corner of the building is to be re-roofed with the Garland Rhino Bond system.
10. Pathways Bathroom: Contractor to raise the flashing on the stucco wall to a minimum of 8" above the finished roof membrane, Contractor to paint the stucco wall with Tuff-Coat, the entire length of the roof, approx. 3 feet above the term bar.

Item #5: Tonopah Office

1. Contractor to replace all vents with new ones
2. Contractor to install term bar, and counter flashing on the parapet wall, install all sealants
3. Contractor to install Tuff-Coat above the counter flashing on the parapet and on the top (2 coats)
4. Contractor to enlarge the existing crickets for proper flow to the internal drains
5. Contractor to paint the intern drain baskets
6. Contractor to install pitch pans to all brackets mounted to the roof system
7. The lower gravel roof on the building is not included in the roof project





Item #1: All locations

1. The designated roof access areas are the following: Roof hatch location, attached ladder location, or the most common spot where the roof is entered, one roof access point walk pad will be required at this point of entry for each roof. Contractor will be required to install a roof access walk pad approx. 3' x 3' each.
2. Roof work can be performed after hours and weekends if the contractor communicates with Nye County School District prior to work, in order to allow the district to notify the school and personal and work around any events scheduled.
3. Nye County School District is only purchasing the material listed on the “Owner Supplied Material” list on the bid package, all other materials will be purchase by the contractor. Contractor to follow the manufactures requirements on the material needed in all roof assemblies in order to provide all warranties.
4. 601 E Calvada Blvd, Pahrump, NV: Material can be stored in the dirt/gravel section of the Maintenance parking lot, contractor to install T-post and temp fencing to secure the material.
5. Tonopah Elem: Material can be stored on site in the parking lot next to the kitchen, this is located on the back of the building, lower parking area. Contractor to install T-post and temp fencing to secure the material.
6. Contractor can access the roof anywhere needed as long as the put up the necessary barriers and do NOT block any main entrances.
