***Principal's General Narrative:***

We started March by taking benchmarks in third through fifth grade. Teachers learned how to use Eduphoria to create and give online assessments. They also learned how to grade the newly constructed response question types using AI, which TEA will be utilizing this year. Teachers reported that they felt it was very beneficial for students to have the opportunity to take a full-length practice STAAR assessment online. Teachers are using the results to provide instruction and intervention for our students. We had TELPAS testing at the end of March for our ESL students.

On March 8th we were able to send approximately 50 of our fourth and fifth-grade students to Laughlin AFB for their Fiesta of Flight STEAM Expo. This was a great learning opportunity for our students and they enjoyed themselves. Thank you to Mrs. Massingill, Ms. Hunter, Mrs. DeLeon, and Mrs. Kerby for chaperoning our students. The second-grade class took their field trip to Devine Acres Farm and the fourth-grade class went to San Antonio to enjoy the Alamo, IMAX viewing of *The Alamo*, and eat at the Rainforest Cafe. Thank you to their teachers and the chaperones who went and ensured that our students were safe and had a great learning experience.

Third through fifth parents attended STAAR parent night. The teachers reviewed a presentation explaining the new STAAR requirements and then the parents and students participated in various Math and Reading activities.

Our students participated in the Special Olympics in Eagle Pass. They did an amazing job. Thank you to Mr. Gomez and his team for all their hard work to make sure that our students were able to participate.

The KCSO sponsored an Easter Egg hunt for PreK through 3rd grade and Life Skills students. Thank you to Sheriff Coe and his team for putting this on for our students!
