Prom Court


If you are interested in running for Prom Court sign up in the office by March 15. This is for Seniors only

Dear Parent or Guardian of Student Athletes:

I wish to inform you of a sports financial assistance program called <u>Every Kid Sports</u> in which any student receiving Medicare, WIC or SNAP will qualify. If you have a student that will be involved in an upcoming sport you can apply online and the program will pay \$95 of the \$105 fee, you pay only \$10. The application period for winter sports has begun. The process opens at **10am daily** and ends when the daily quota is filled. This is not a guaranteed payment, the sooner you apply the better your chances of being approved.

To apply go to: everykidsports.org

Under <u>Parent Portal</u> choose <u>EKS Pass Page</u> then choose <u>apply</u> and fill out the application, it only takes about five minutes to apply.

Below is some information you may need for the application:

- > The dates your sport starts and ends:
- Basketball November 18, 2024 February 9, 2025
- Wrestling November 18, 2024 February 27, 2025
- Cheer November 18, 2024 March 4, 2025
- > Hours of participation per week: 18
- > Organization hosting your sport: Illinois Valley High School

- Cost of sport registration: \$105
- Grant amount requested: \$95

You will need to attach and submit your Medicare, WIC or SNAP information to your Every Kid Sports application. Funds are not available for previous sports participation.

Once approved, typically within 8-11 days, ChekSpend will email you a digital debit card number, you <u>must call me</u> with that number and I will credit you your grant amount. If you don't receive it, check your spam or trash.
