Minidoka County School District Food Service Report April 2017

Claims;

- The reimbursement figures for April are as follows. The total amount is \$198,830.94 for 2017 and we had \$187,112.14 in 2016. We served 20 days this year and 19 days last year.
- The number of breakfasts served in 2017 was 45,090 compared to 44,530 in 2016. We are still showing an increase of 560 this year.
- The number of lunches served in 2017 was 52,952 compared to 50,409 in 2016. We averaged 2,641 last year for April and 2,648 this year for April. So you can see that we are about the same with our lunch counts. We are looking at new menu items for next year and will be looking to set up taste testing at the schools to get feedback from the students.

Projects;

- I have been to the Rupert and Heyburn City councils and have received permission to use the Lincoln and Neptune parks in Rupert and the Central park in Heyburn for lunch in the park this summer. I will go the Paul City council on May 10th.
- We are moving forward with the remodel of our warehouse and are still hopeful to get it done by school starts back up in August.
