1. Opening and Call to Order Board Chair

Chair Gregg welcomed everyone and called the work session to order at 8:05 a.m.

1.1. Pledge of Allegiance

The group stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

1.2. Meeting Audio/Video Recorded

Chair Gregg stated that this meeting is being audio and video recorded.

2. **ODE Integrated Application** Julie Smith

Dr. Smith presented the Oregon Department of Education Integrated Application Documents for the Pendleton School District, which include the Integrated Plan Summary, Policy JBB – Educational Equity, the IMESD Decision Making tool – Equity Lens, the Integrated Application Narrative Responses, the Outcomes and Strategies for 2025-27, and the Budget Program for 2025-27. The last page of the summary is the Pendleton School District 2025-2027 Integrated Plan Snapshot. The board is to review the documents today and will approve them at the next board meeting. She was available for questions.

3. FirstView Dashboard 1.0 Matt Yoshioka

First Student updated their bus tracking system, and Mr. Yoshioka shared a little bit about it, showing the administrator dashboard. All the secretaries and admins in the district have access to their specific schools' dashboard. It shows real-time tracking of the buses, a timestamp when the bus doors open and close, and arrival times. Parents can download an app and set up a geofence to get notifications when their student's bus is within the area. It is beneficial for schools and parents alike.

4. Policy - First Reading Michelle Jones

4.1. EHB – Cybersecurity

Due to an increase in cybersecurity issues in schools nationwide, OSBA has released an optional policy.

5. Policies – First Reading Matt Yoshioka

5.1. AC – Nondiscrimination and Civil Rights

Reverting to the previous version from March 2023 due to the overturning of recent Title IX policies.

5.2. GBN/JBA – Sexual Harassment

Reverting to the previous version from March 2023 due to the overturning of recent Title IX policies.

5.3. IIA – Instructional Materials

Tightens up process for instructional materials approval and reconsideration requests/complaints from students, parents, or community members.

5.4. IKF – Graduation Requirements

Adds in the new credit requirements (.5 credit personal finance, .5 credit career pathway, and .5 credit US civics). Removes "alternate certificate" option and adds "certificate of attendance" option.

5.5. IKFB - Graduation Exercises

Removes "alternate certificate" option and adds "certificate of attendance" option. Better defines "Native American items allowed of cultural significance."

5.6. JBA/GBN – Sexual Harassment

Reverting to the previous version from March 2023 due to the overturning of recent Title IX policies.

5.7. JECA – Admission of Resident Students

Clarifies the right to not admit resident students expelled from another district for a weapons violation but still allows an online option if the district has one to offer and chooses to allow it.
