United Way of Odessa 2021 Top Fundraisers: United Way Executive Director Hank Herrick and United Way Assistant Executive Director Christina Escobar presented ECISD with two awards – the United Way Odessa 2021 Most Improved Campaign Award and the 2021 Dick & Amelia Saulsbury Sustained Excellence Award.
