Item Name: CONSIDER APPROVAL OF 2024-2025 CAMPUS & DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT PLANS

Item Summary: The District Improvement Plan (DIP) is a comprehensive plan required by state and local legislation. It outlines goals, strategies, and actions aimed at improving student performance and district-wide operations. The DIP addresses academic achievement for all student groups, aligning with state and federal accountability standards. It includes objectives for curriculum, instruction, staff development, resource allocation, and school climate. The plan is designed through collaboration with district stakeholders, including educators, parents, and community members, ensuring that it reflects local needs and promotes continuous school improvement.

Campuses are also required to develop an annual Campus Improvement Plan to target and address student needs. All plans contain a Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA), which identifies priority areas in need of improvement. Based upon the CNA, each campus outlines goals, objectives and strategies, and dedicated resources to be used in the current school year to improve and support student performance.

Additionally, the District and Campus Improvement Plans are aligned to and support the tenants of the Texas Education Agency's continuous improvement process and the Lamar CISD Strategic Plan. As such, the plans serve as blueprints for sustaining growth toward meeting increasing state accountability standards.
