TOPIC: Approval to Purchase Mobile Devices for Students

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 405 Dell Chromebooks for students who have a non-school issued device at home but are not able to bring the device to school, for a total cost of \$159,975.00.

RATIONALE:

The purchase of the Dell Chromebooks will provide additional Chromebooks in order to have more devices in our schools for students to use during the school day. This recommendation has also been reviewed and supported by the Board Curriculum Committee.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The funds for this purchase were secured through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund grant (ESSER) which was targeted at providing materials and services to reduce the digital divide and support students during this pandemic.
