Subject: Shared Services Arrangement Agreement with Dallas Regional Day School Program for the Deaf (See Attached Agreement.)

Action Item

BOARD GOAL:

Design and implement a rigorous instructional delivery system that is data-driven and fosters student engagement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Cedar Hill ISD does not have a sufficient number of students who are deaf to provide services in the district. Therefore, in order to provide a full continuum of services for deaf students as required by federal law, Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act 2004 (IDEA 2004), CHISD has maintained a Shared Services Arrangement Agreement with Dallas Regional Day School Program for the Deaf (RDSPD). Students living in Cedar Hill who are deaf attend one of the cluster sites of the Dallas RDSPD. CHISD has participated in this program for several years and has been very pleased with the outstanding services provided. This agreement is for the 2009-2010 school year. This is a cost effective way to provide services for CHISD students who are deaf.
